- ¼ yard Benartex A New Leaf Watercolor Stripe Jade #3446-45 (background)
- ¼ yard Benartex A New Leaf Layered Leaves Indigo Multi #3442-55 (border)
- ½ yard Benartex A New Leaf Pinwheel Swirl Jade #3441-44 (backing)
- ¼ yard solid (lower sash border and bias binding)
- Appliqué Fuse and Fix
- Assorted Fabric scraps for appliqué
- Polymesh Stabilizer
- Organ Titanium Needles Sizes 80
- 1 yard Grosgrain Ribbon (for napkin ring)

Threads

- Isacord Thread for embroidery refer to collection
- · Embroidery Bobbin thread

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Designing the Placemat


- · Open the BERNINA Embroidery Software 7.
- Locate the Application Launcher and from the drop down menu select Quilter.
- Select the Layout icon > 1 block that measure 12" x 5" > a 2" sashed horizontal border > add 2.5" horizontal outer border. The finished placemat is 17" x 14". Click OK.
- Open the Library and click on the fabrics tab. Scroll down to A New Leaf* fabric folder > click the + sign to open.
 - Select the fabric Watercolor Stripe Jade 3446-45 and place in the body of the runner and the upper sashed border
 - Select a solid fabric for the lower sashed border
 - Select fabric the Layered Leaves Indigo Multi 3442-55 for the outer border.



- File > Save As > A New Leaf Placemat with Fabric.
- Select the Embroidery Window (alternately select File > Insert Embroidery).
- When Embroidery Canvas opens, select the Insert Embroidery icon (alternately select File > Insert Embroidery). Navigate to the A New Leaf Embroidery Collection folder > Open > Select File 21013-10 > Open > File > Save and Return. Drag and drop into place and fine tune placement using keyboard arrows.
- Select the Embroidery Window (alternately select File > Insert Embroidery).
- When Embroidery Canvas opens select the Insert Embroidery icon (alternately select File > Insert Embroidery). Navigate to the A New Leaf Design Collection folder > Open > Select File 21013-29 > Open > Select the Mirror Merge Toolbox > click on Mirror Merge Horizontal > select the Mirror and click on the Mirror Horizontal icon > File > Save As > Scroll Border
- File > Save and Return. Drag and drop into place and fine tune placement using keyboard arrows.
- File > Save As > A New Leaf Placemat Final.


Cutting and Construction

- Cut A New Leaf Watercolor Stripe Jade 3446-45 background fabric 121/2" x 71/2"
- Cut the solid fabric 12½" x 2½"
- Cut the border 2—2½" x 9½" and 2—17" x 2½"
- Construct the placemat using a ¼" seam allowance.


















Embroidery

- Iron Fusible Polymesh to the wrong side of the fabric.
- Print a template of the design > mark the center on the fabric > hoop > Send designs to the machine > stitch.
- Re-hoop to stitch the Scroll Border.

Quilting

- Layer the backing, batting and placemat. Quilt as desired.
- Zig-zag or serge around the edge of the runner to keep all layers together.

Binding


- Bind using the 28mm BERNINA Binder attachment #88 with matching binder foot #95/95C.
 - Pre-starch and cut the fabric on the bias, 1½" wide. Stitch together to make continuous binding.
- Begin in the middle of one side leaving a 2" to 3" tail and stitch the binding to the very edge and backstitch. Lock the stitches and cut the thread.
- Pivot the binder out and pull the piece back exposing about 3-4 inches of binding fabric.
- Finger press.
- Manipulate the miter on the back matching the folded ends. Pin with the head of the pin facing out.
- Do the same in front and pin so the point of the pin is facing out.
- Pull the excess binding back into the binder making sure the placemat is encased.
- Lower the needle into the inside corner, remove the pins and continue stitching.
- End by stopping and leaving a tail. Join to the starting tail and stitch using the Edgestitch Foot #10.

Napkins


- Layer 2 fabrics Pebble 3443-55 Indigo Multi and Swirling Vine 3444-42 Moss right sides together and cut a16½" square.
- Stitch together leaving an opening for turning. Press back the seam allowance on the opening.
- · Turn > Press.
















Napkin Rings

- Open A New Leaf design 21013-12 in the BERNINA Embroidery Software 7.
- While the design is selected > Select the StumpWork Toolbox > Click on the Create StumpWork border icon > select Properties > Place a check next to Use wire gauge > Use the down arrow next to wire gauge and select 32 > OK.
- Change the border Placement to .02 inches > OK .
- Click to place a cut in the StumpWork border to allow an opening for the wires or Press escape to have the wire totally enclosed. Send the base design and StumpWork to the machine.
- Open the design in the machine and duplicate. Use Move Motif to position in the hoop.
- Iron Appliqué Fuse and Fix to a scrap of fabric for the leaf appliqué to create a fabric sticker.
- Hoop the Polymesh stabilizer.
- Stitch the placement line, place the pre-cut fabric sticker on the placement line and stitch the design.
- Remove the hoop from the machine and from the underside of the hoop cover all of the stitching with fabric pieces. A little spritz of 505 Temporary Spray adhesive will keep the fabric in place while the hoop is returned to the machine.
- Stitch the placement line for the wire.
- To lay down the wire use Echo Quilting and CutWork foot #44C or Free-motion Embroidery Foot #24.
- Lower the machine speed and use the foot control to stitch the wire in place.
- Change to the same thread top and bobbin. Stitch the cover stitch.
- Use the CutWork Tool or scissors to trim.
- Attach Reverse Pattern Foot #1/1C/1D. Use a straight stitch to attach the leaf to the ribbon.
- Optional Crystals: use the CrystalWork Software and Tool to add crystals to the napkin ring or a Glitz tool.
