Purpose

- For cover and chainstitch work.
- To compensate for unilateral fabric thicknesses.
- For stitching edges.

For your safety

Markings and guides

- A Right guide
- B Right coverstitch needle RC
- C Center coverstitch needle CC
- D Left coverstitch needle LC
- E Left guide

Application

Generally to be observed

The height-flexible presser foot sole allows efficient compensation while sewing different fabric thicknesses. Optimal results can be achieved by observing the following guidelines.

- Before sewing the project together, hem or topstitch the edges first.
- Optimize the fabric feed along unilateral seams by using remnant fabric as height compensation.

Sewing along the right guide

- > Place the fabric under the presser foot (right side up). Position the edge against the inner right guide. (Fig. 2)
- > When sewing small curves or circles, use only LC/CC needles.

Sewing along the left guide

- > Place the fabric under the presser foot (right side up). Position the edge against the inner left guide. (Fig. 3)
- > When sewing small curves or circles, use only CC/RC needles.
