

ROW AND QUILT ASSEMBLY (SEE DIAGRAMS FOR PROPER BLOCK ROTATION.)

12. Sew each row vertically then sew the 3 rows together
Row 1: I 2-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle>Block 1>Block 5>Block 2>Block 5>Block 1>I 2-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle.

Row 2: BLOCK 6>BLOCK 3>BLOCK 6>BLOCK 4>BLOCK 6

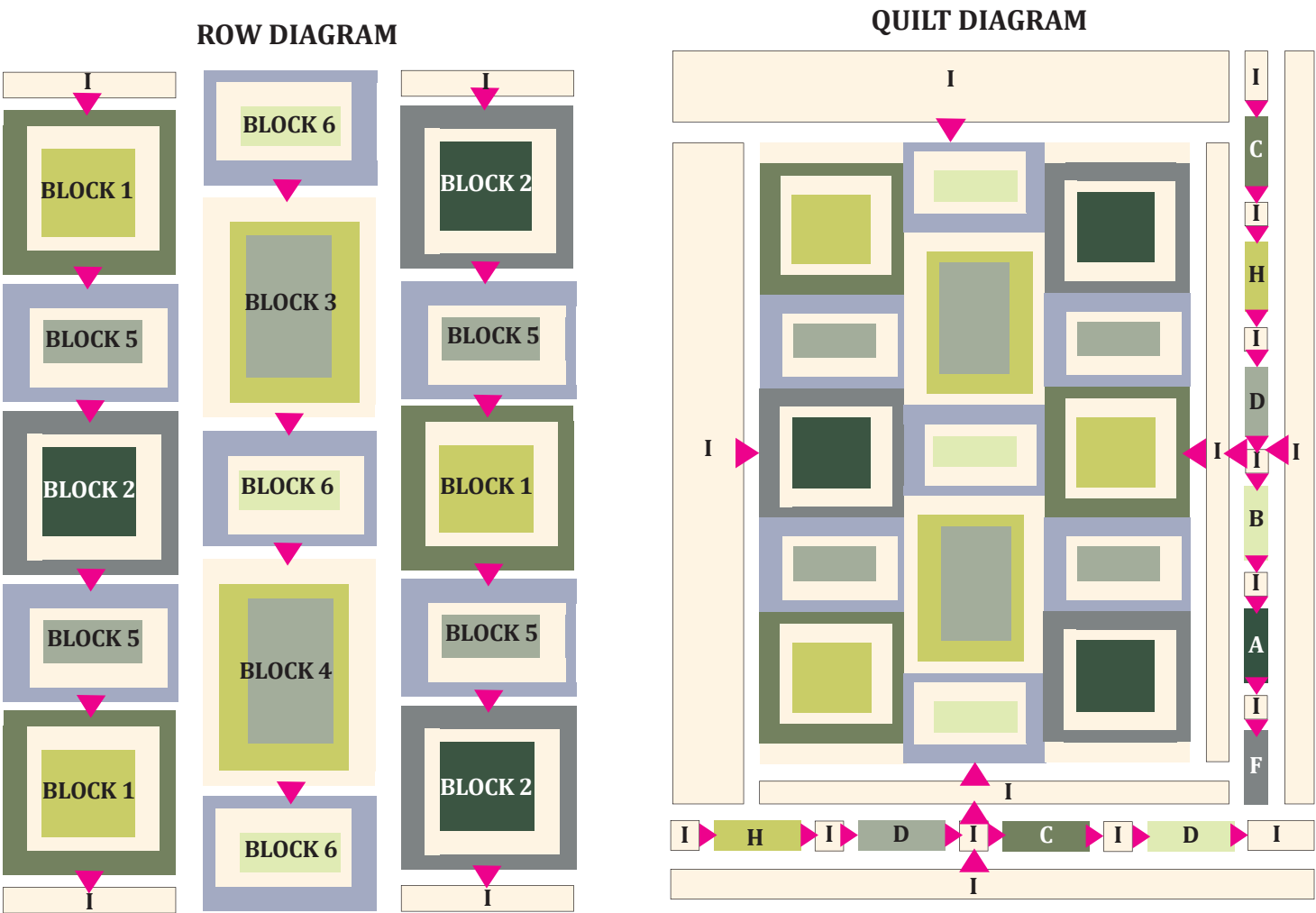
Row 3: I 2-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle>Block 2>Block 5>Block 1>Block 5>Block 2> I 2-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle

Border Assembly: *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.*

BORDER 1:
13. Sew (1) I 2-1/2" X (56-1/2") strip to right side of quilt, then sew (1) I 2-1/2" X (38-1/2") strip to bottom of quilt. Sew (1) I 6 ½" x (58 ½") strip to left side of quilt, then sew (1) I 6 ½" x (44 ½") strip to top of quilt.

BORDER 2:
14. Sew the following together, then sew to right side of quilt: I 2-1/2" X 3-1/2" rectangle>C 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle>I 2-1/2" square>H 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle> I 2-1/2" square> D 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle> I 2-1/2" square> B 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle>I 2-1/2" square>A 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle> I 2-1/2" square> F 2-1/2" X 9" rectangle. Then sew I 3-1/2" X (64-1/2") strip to right side of quilt.

15. Sew the following together, then sew to bottom of quilt: I 3-1/2" square>H 3-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle>I 3-1/2" square>D 3-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle>I 3-1/2" square>C 3-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle>I 3-1/2" square>B 3-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle> I 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle. Then sew (1) I 3-1/2" X (49-1/2") strip to bottom of quilt.



Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.

FINISHING : Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Finished Quilt Size: 49" W x 70"L

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




Wonky Blox

(3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips*, BORDER (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips*, BORDER (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (1) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle (4) 3-1/2" squares (1) 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips*, BORDER (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles (6) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles (6) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles (6) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles (7) 2-1/2" x 3" rectangles (5) 2-1/2" squares (2) 2" x WOF strips, subcut (7) 2" x 9-1/2" rectangles (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles (2) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles (13) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles (6) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles (7) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles	

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

BLOCKS 1 & 2:
1. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangle to the right side of (1) **H** 6 1/2" square, then sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to the left side. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 9 1/2" rectangle to the bottom, then sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle to the top to create **BLOCK CENTER**.

2. Sew (1) **C** 2 1/2" X 9 1/2" rectangle to the right side of **BLOCK CENTER**, then sew (1) **C** 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle to the left side. Sew (1) **C** 2 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the bottom, then sew (1) **C** 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the top to create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 12 1/2", *(Make 3)*.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using **A** squares, **I** rectangles and **F** rectangles to create **BLOCK 2**. *(Make 3)*.



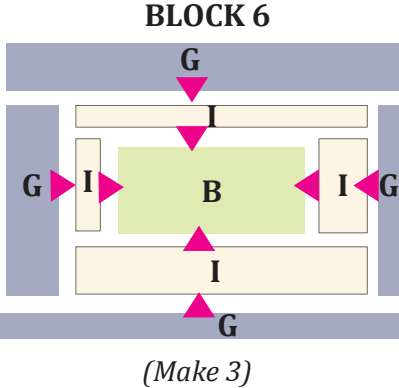
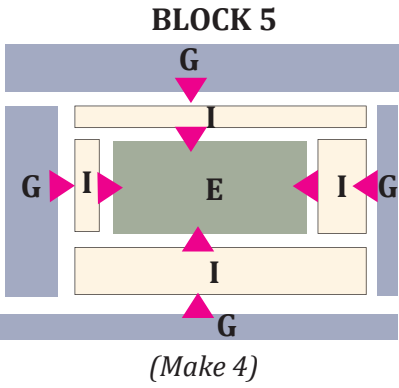
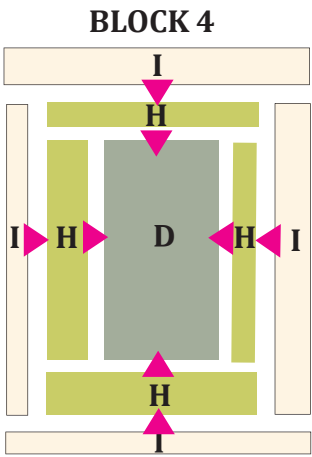
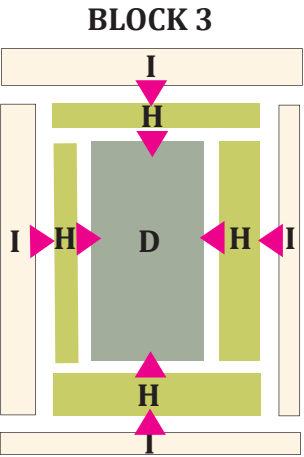
BLOCKS 3 & 4:
4. Sew (1) **H** 1 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangle to one side of (1) **D** 6 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) **H** 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangle to the other side to create **HD** unit. *(Make 2)*.

5. With the 2 1/2" **H** rectangle on the right side, sew (1) **H** 2 1/2" X 9 1/2" rectangle to the bottom of **HD** unit, then sew (1) **H** 1 1/2" X 9 1/2" rectangle to the top to create **BLOCK 3** Center.

6. With the 2 1/2" **H** rectangle on the left side, sew (1) **H** 2 1/2" X 9 1/2" strip to the bottom of other **HD** unit, then sew (1) **H** 1 1/2" X 9 1/2" strip to the top to create **BLOCK 4** Center.

7. Sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" X 13 1/2" to the left side of **BLOCK 3** Center, then sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 13 1/2" to the right side. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the bottom, then sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the top to complete **BLOCK 3**. Square to 12 1/2" X 16 1/2".

8. Sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" X 13 1/2" to the right side of **BLOCK 4** Center, then sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 13 1/2" to the left side. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the bottom, then sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the top to complete **BLOCK 4**. Square to 12 1/2" X 16 1/2".



Blocks 5 & 6:
9. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 3" rectangle to the left side of (1) **E** 3" X 6 1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) **I** 2 1/2" x 3" rectangle to the right side. Sew (1) **I** 1 1/2" X 9 1/2" rectangle to the top, then sew (1) **I** 2" x 9 1/2" rectangle to the bottom to create **BLOCK CENTER**.

10. Sew (1) **G** 2 1/2" X 5 1/2" rectangle to the left side of Block Center, then sew (1) **G** 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangle to the right side. Sew (1) **G** 2 1/2" X 12 1/2" rectangle to the top, then sew (1) **G** 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the bottom to create **BLOCK 5**. Square to 8 1/2" X 12 1/2", *(Make 4)*.

11. Repeat steps 9 and 10 using **B** rectangles, **I** rectangles and **G** rectangles to create **BLOCK 6**, *(Make 3)*.
