PatternCad Design to Pantograph

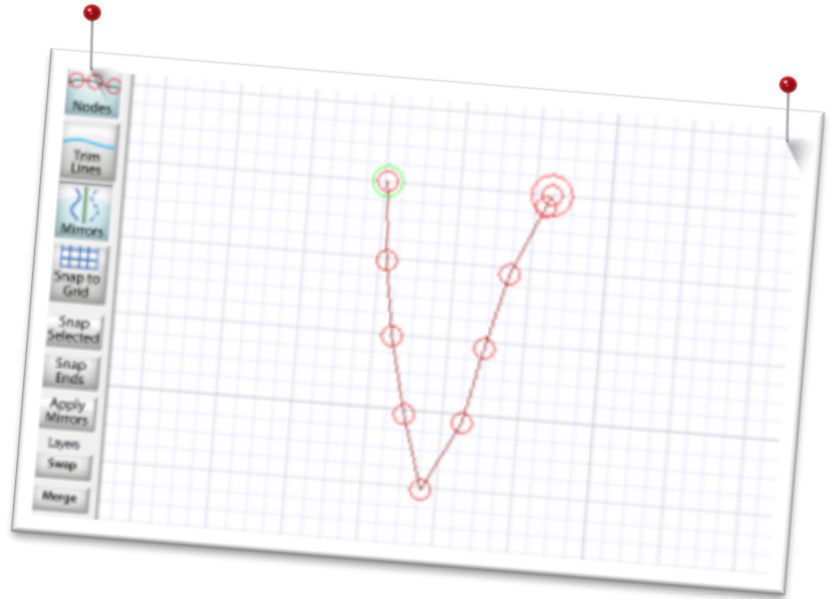

Use **QuiltMotion Touch for BERNINA** to create a **Crosshatch** design. The crosshatch design can be used as a single design or in a **Pantograph** for all over quilting.

Supplies

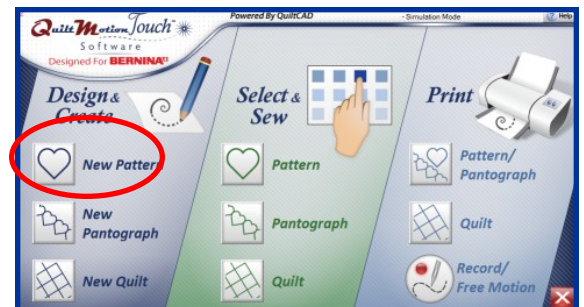
Machine & Accessories

- BERNINA 830, 820 or 7 Series
- BERNINA Quilting Frame
- QuiltMotion Touch for BERNINA Software

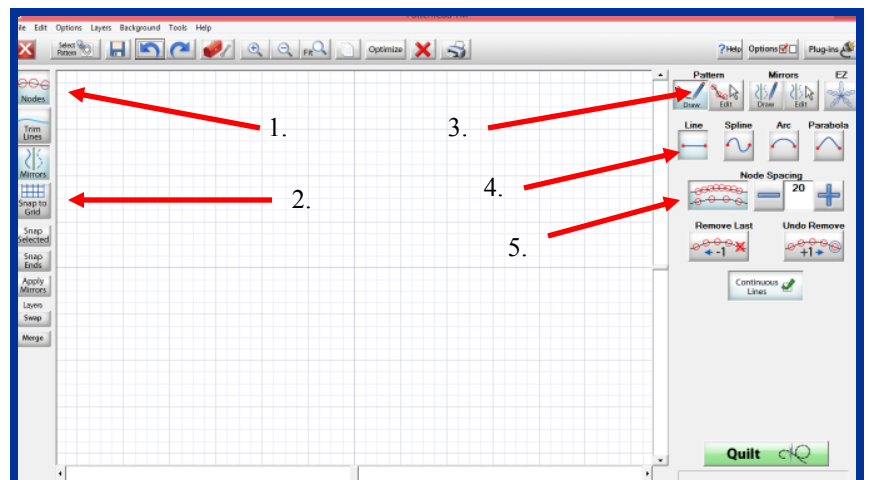


PatternCad

- Select **New Pattern** under **Design & Create** to open **PatternCad**.



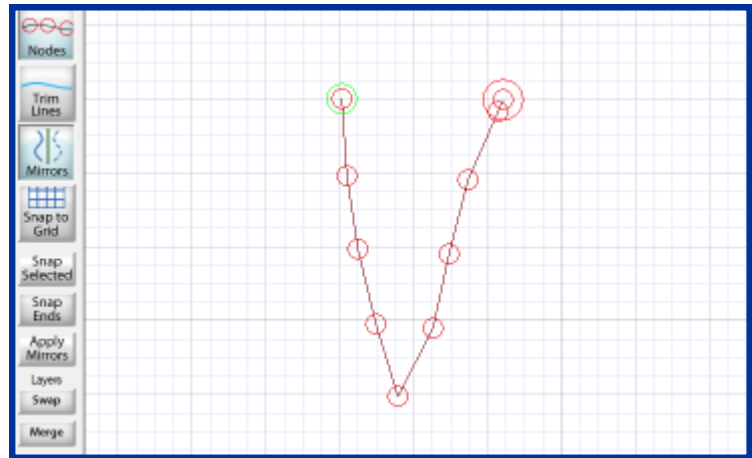
- When the new screen opens
 1. Select **Nodes**
 2. Deselect **Snap to Grid**
 3. Select **Draw** under **Patterns**
 4. Select **Line**
 5. Change **Node Spacing** to 20.



- With a left click of the mouse-click and drag the shape you wish to draw on the work surface
- If the line does not look like you want clear the screen using the large **RED X** in the top tool bar

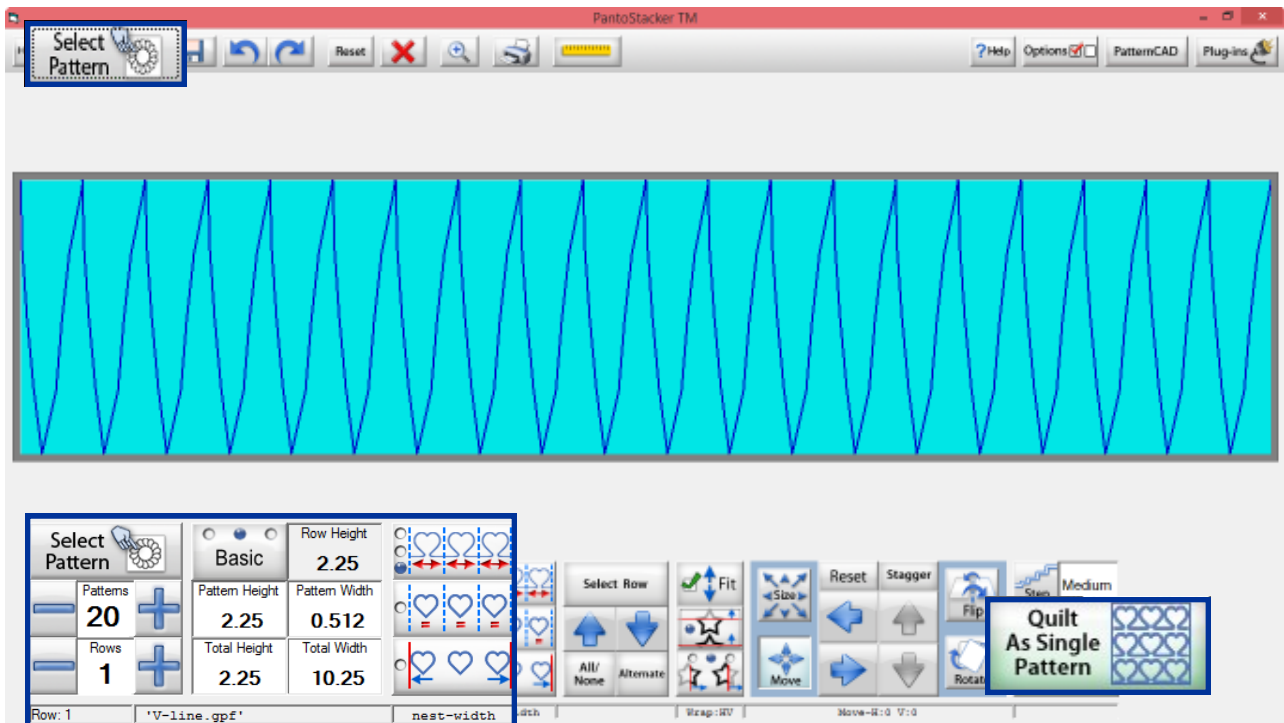
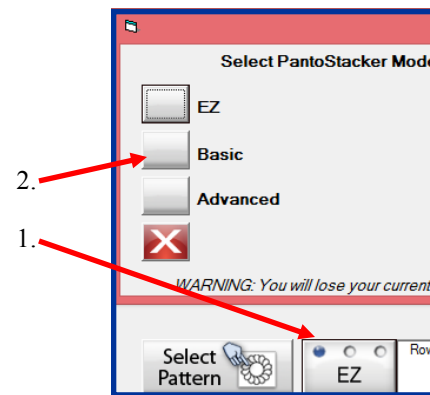


- When finished save with the **SAVE** icon in top tool bar to the folder of choice.
- Return to **Home Screen**.

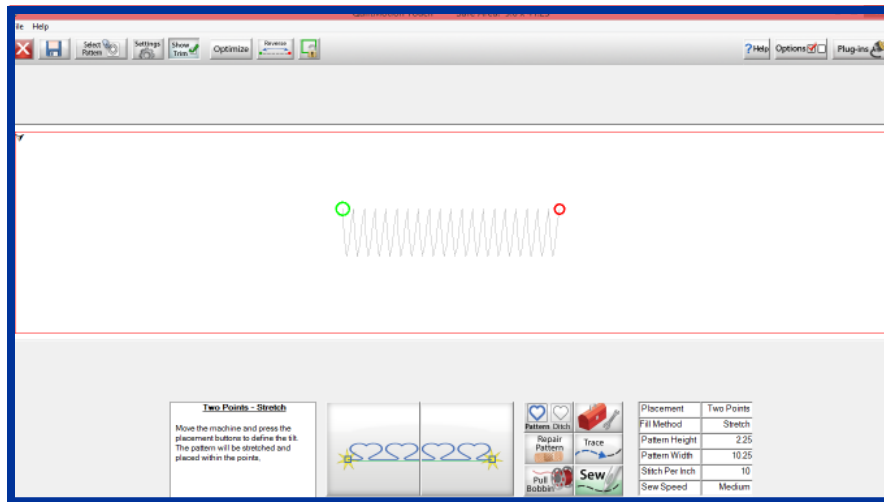


Creating Pantograph

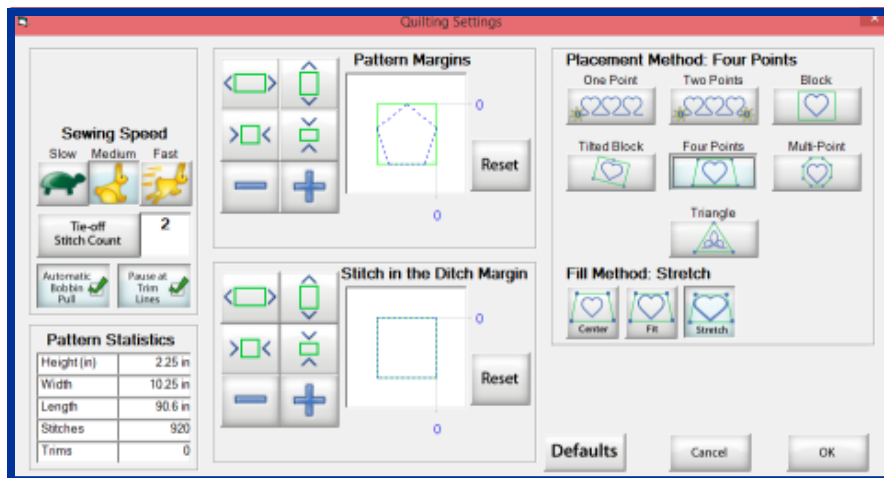
- Open **New Pantograph** under **Design & Create** on **Home Screen**.
- Set **Safe Area** if needed.
- Change **PantoStacker Mode** to **Basic** by clicking on current mode then select **Basic**.
- Enter the **Total Height** and the **Total Width** of the area the pantograph will be placed in **Select Pattern** and open in **PantoStacker**.
- Edit the number of **Patterns** to be repeated.
- **Neat as needed**.
- Select **Quilt As Single Pattern**.



Placing Pantograph as a Single Design



- When **QuiltMotion** screen opens select placement method by clicking **Settings** at the top of the screen or clicking the **Sewing Information** table on the lower right of screen.
- These placement methods are the same as blocks when using the **Quilt As Single Row**
- Click **Sew** to complete the pattern on the project.



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
